

Official Contest Rules

SBH Elementary School Art Contest Submission Deadline October 18th 2017

Contest Overview

Community students enrolled in kindergarten through eighth grade are invited to participate in the SBH “I Can Do Hesed” art contest to create artwork for the 2017 SBH “I Can Do Hesed” Coloring Book. Each entry will promote the SBH Hesed initiative in order to encourage others to get involved in Hesed.

Winning designs will be displayed on the back cover of the SBH “I Can Do Hesed” Coloring Book. All artwork may be showcased on the SBH website and social media sites.

All entries must be submitted by October 18th, 2017. Winners will be announced in November. Entry is free of charge. Contest rules and dates may be changed at the discretion of SBH.

Contest Rules

- Artwork must be submitted on or before October 18th, 2017. Late entries will be disqualified.
- Artwork must be original work created by a community student enrolled in kindergarten through 8th grade.
- Each student may submit only one work of art.
- Each student’s parent or legal guardian must fill out and sign the Contest Entry Form and Agreement. Any artwork submitted without the Contest Entry Form and Agreement will be disqualified.
- The student’s name must be written in pencil *only* on the back of artwork. Names should not appear on the front of the artwork.
- Artwork should not be folded or damaged.
- All submitted artwork is owned by SBH. Winners agree to the use of their names/pictures to promote the SBH “I Can Do Hesed” Coloring Book and other SBH programming. Entries will not be returned.

- No obligation or liability is assumed by SBH in connection with the contest.

Eligibility

Applicants must be students in grades K-8 as of September 2017, and must comply with these Official Rules.

Design Rules

- All entries should promote the SBH mission:
 - “Kindness through service – delivered with care, compassion, and a commitment to excellence. To improve and maintain the health and well-being of individuals and families – helping them lead productive and independent lives. Committed to the dignity, worth, and abilities of each person”.
- Entries may illustrate the “I Can Do Hesed” theme or the SBH Logo. No other company logos, product brands, brand names, characters (i.e. Mickey Mouse, Barbie, Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles, etc.) or store names are allowed (i.e. Coke, 7-Eleven, etc.). Generic terms such as “restaurant” or “store” may be used.
- The student’s name must be written in pencil *only* on the back of artwork. If selected, the winner’s name will be printed next to his or her design.
- artwork should be submitted on an 8.5” x 11” piece of paper (in portrait format)
- Entries should not be framed or mounted.
- All artwork should be two-dimensional, using any of the following: watercolor, acrylic or oil paints, colored pencil, colored markers, ink, charcoal, pastels, and crayons. Collages, computer-generated artwork, photography, traced images, or photocopies will be disqualified.

Judging

- Entries will be judged based on creativity/uniqueness, inclusion of a Hesed message and interpretation of the SBH mission, overall visual appeal, composition, and age appropriateness.
- All judgments are final.

- Entries will be judged by an SBH appointed committee.

Prizes

Three winners will be selected.

- Winning designs will be featured on the back cover of the SBH “I Can Do Hessed Coloring Book”.
- All contest entries may be showcased online.

Artwork Submission

All submissions of original designs must be dropped off with accompanying signed Contest Entry Form and Agreement to participating SBH Offices on or before October 18th, 2017.
